*Lockeford Springs, Saturday April 2, 2005* – when the CGC last played here in 2000, there were twice as many scores above net 80 (8) as below net 72 (4) – and hitting out of the rough was like playing in the U.S. Open! We just played the course last week – the Men's tees have been shortened by over 500 yards, while the Women's tees have been shortened by over 400 yards, with rough now similar to most Sacramento area courses.
