A couple of the greens had trouble through the heat of the Summer, and the temporary green on the short, yet intriguing 18th hole was disappointing. However, other than the 15th and 18th greens, the greens were in overall better shape than some previous years (as we normally schedule our event in the Fall, about 2 ½ weeks after aeration), giving everyone a better feel for the excellent roll these greens generally produce. With all the new homes being built near and around Marysville, this course may not be the best kept secret and best golfing value in the area for much longer!
