Upcoming Events

Monterey trip, August 3- 5 – we have completely filled up the available slots for this trip (with 34 players for Thursday, and 36 players for Friday and Saturday). Bass Lake, Saturday June 10 (10:00 A start) – this is another first time course for the CGC. With the two nines being built at different times, the one nine plays quite compacted and through the trees, while the other nine is a little more open and a little more hilly.
