Upcoming Events

Ancil Hoffman, Monday August 28 (9:30 A start) – entry forms went out with our last newsletter within the last two weeks, and entries received thus far have been sparse (6 entries received through August 7). Without a minimum of 16 players, we will not go forward with this event. We have to finalize our player count with the course by August 14 – if you are interested in playing, please contact Alan or Deb via email (rankingolf@aol.com) or telephone (916 386-8132) by no later than Sunday evening August 13 with your commitment to play.

Poppy Ridge, Sunday September 24 (10:00 A start) – this will be the CGC's first trek to the NCGA's 'other' course, located in Livermore. Poppy Ridge, like Poppy Hills, has an extended reservation policy - in that we have to finalize our player count and make payment 31 days in advance of the event. Thus, we have a very short window for collecting entry forms for this event. Results from Monterey weekend, August 3- 5, 2006

After the final round of the CGC's 2004 trip to Monterey, the members who made that trip voted unanimously to make the Monterey trip an 'every other year' event. With an increase in CGC membership in 2006, this year's Monterey trip became our largest gathering for an out of town weekend golfing trip – 32 players for Thursday at Del Monte, 36 players for Friday at Poppy Hills, and 33 players for Saturday at Pajaro Valley. The weather was beautiful, as we saw the sun (in a much calmer intensity than we've seen recently in Sacramento) all 3 days, with comfortable ocean breezes. Our only planned group get together away from the course, at Fandango's in Pacific Grove on Friday night, brought together 32 people (including some spouses) for a very lively evening.

We'd like to thank Donna Johnson for her efforts in scheduling the golf courses for this trip – her dogged efforts (especially in getting us back on Poppy Hills for the first time since 2001) are greatly appreciated. Debbie Rankin made all of the arrangements for the Fandango's dinner, not a small task for a group this size. Shelley Barr, Terry Barr, and Marty Solov helped with scoring the first day at Del Monte to help ease the burden in getting results ready for announcements after the final round at Pajaro Valley.

The golfing highlight of the trip had to be Sylvia Cisneros' eagle 3 on the par 5 13th hole at Del Monte. The biggest surprise of the trip was the relative difficulty of Del Monte and Pajaro Valley – Poppy Hills yielded the most net sub-par rounds (7) and the fewest net scores of 80 and above (9)

Per the questionnaire results received in May/June 2006, we are tentatively looking at a 2 day Foothills trip and a 3 day trip to either the Central Coast or the Mount Shasta area in 2007. We will let you know more as we begin to put our 2007 schedule together how this all shakes out.

Only 6 additional such shots were made the last 2 days (2 at Poppy Hills and 4 at Pajaro Valley)
