## Upcoming Events

## Results from Poppy Ridge, September 24, 2006

We completed the NCGA Poppy (Hills and Ridge) double play in 2006 with the CGC's first event at Poppy Ridge near Livermore. 34 players took advantage of the opportunity to play this course, which plays distinctly differently than the Monterey version. Links style golf, exposed to the conditions of the day – and with apparently difficult greens (based on the putting numbers for the day).
