A group of 39 players (38 members and 1 guest) enjoyed the beautiful day and course conditions – overall Mather was in excellent shape. Even though the course yardage is long compared to many courses in the area, the open fairways and lack of numerous treacherous holes made for a day where good scores could be had, with one-third of the players (13) breaking net par on the day. We also ended up with 3 first-time CGC winners in the four flights!
