## Upcoming Events

When we were looking at a Carson City trip for 2008, this course was going to again begin our trip – when we switched the away trip to the Graeagle area, we decided to keep this course on our schedule by moving it to a September date. This event is between other tournaments that day, so we are limited to 28 players for this event – so if you know now that you are planning to play this event, it might be good to get your entry form in early.

## Results from Hiddenbrooke, July 12, 2008

This was another first time venue for the CGC, and a group of 30 players (28 members and 2 guests) made the trip. With all of the heat and smokey conditions in the Valley, the cooler temperatures and breezes were a welcome relief for most. The course, while not long, is highly rated due to the number of forced carries and challenging greens. Most of the players we talked to would play the course again – feeling that a little knowledge of where to hit certain shots could definitely improve the score. We'll keep an eye out for deals at this course in the future (it's a little pricey at its' regular weekend prices).
