## **CGC Involvement in NCGA Associate Club events**

After limited participation in recent years, we decided to get CGC members more involved in NCGA Associate Club events in 2009. Of the four events available, we will have entries in 3 of the 4 events (the only one we did not have an entry was the Senior 2 person best ball, since the qualifier was the day before our Monterey trip).

So far this year, the Club has been represented well. We had 2 teams in the 2 person best ball qualifier – Terry Barr and Alan Rankin qualified at Haggin Oaks with a net best ball 64 and played in the Championship at Poppy Hills and Spyglass Hill in late June, finishing tied for 32nd out of 56 teams. Our other team, Larry Marietti and Greg Paulo, was in contention at the qualifier at Haggin Oaks until falling short in the last few holes.

Our 4 person best ball team of Larry Daniels, Danny Olaivar, Patrick Stiehr and Craig Wahlquist made it through their first qualifier at Castle Oaks with a two net best ball score of 129. They failed to make it through the second qualifier at Poppy Ridge in mid July. All 4 players expressed their appreciation for representing the Club in this event.

In the upcoming individual net stroke play qualifier, we will have 4 members representing the CGC – Greg Brewster, Donna Johnson, John McLaughlin and Ken Worman. The qualifier is September 10 – if any of our members qualify, the Championship will be held at Poppy Hills in early October.

The team events have maximum indexes eligible of 18.4 – so our future teams will mainly consist of CGC members at our below that index level. The individual net stroke play event allows full indexes up to 36.4 men, 40.4 women – so our future qualifiers will mainly come from our CGC members with indexes above 18.4. We will use results from the prior year CGC events to help determine qualifiers for these events.
