Results from Ancil Hoffman, September 12, 2009

Unlike the weather day at Paradise Valley two weeks earlier, this September day began with the smell of rain. A couple of brief showers before the group teed off kept the temperature down for the most part. A group of 40 players were in good spirits and seemed to welcome the changing conditions. Eleven of the 40 players broke net par, with CGC veterans taking home the low net honors in all 4 flights (all 4 flight winners have double digit CGC victories). While not in bad shape, there were areas of the course that are beginning to show the strain of fewer financial resources available to maintain the overall course quality we've come to expect at most area courses in recent years. It will be interesting to see how courses hold up in the coming months.
